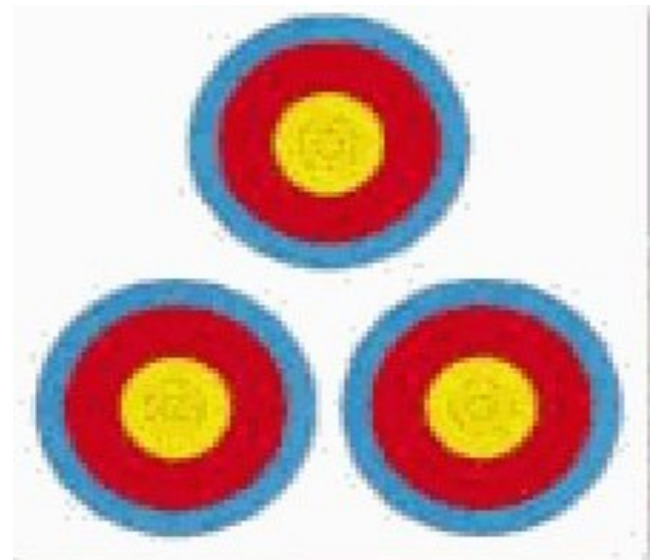

## FITA Rule Book Constitutions & Rules 2009

- Article 4.2.2.1 At each competition an athlete can compete in one class only. This applies to all classes for which he is eligible.
- Article 4.3.8 Athletes may compete in different divisions of the same event but under no circumstances may the program of the event be modified or the event be held up to accommodate that athlete.
- Article 4.5.2.3 The 18 meter FITA Indoor Round consists of 60 arrows on 40cm diameter faces or 40cm triple faces for all classes.
- Article 8.2.2.1 Rounds and faces.  
For the Indoor Match Round, the triple 40 cm faces will be used. In the Elimination and Finals Round the faces will be set in pairs on each target butt. Vertical triple faces will be mandatory for the Indoor Target World Championship. The use of single or triple faces in all other competitions is the choice of the organizers, who can allow the athletes in the same class and division to shoot on a different type of face.
- Article 5.2.1 A new record will be established when a score is at least one point higher, or in Flight Shooting, the distance shot is one centimetre further, than an existing Record.
- Article 5.2.2 In case of a perfect score shot in Outdoor Target Archery a new record will include the number of Inner 10s (X's) and will require at least one more X than an existing Record.

Book 1, Article 5.3  
Question: How are World records recognized with regard to athlete's classes?  
Answer: A World record is always recognized in the class in which the athlete belongs by his/her age, no matter in which class he/she was registered at the tournament where he/she performed the record.  
In addition: A Men/Women World record is recognized if performed by a Master, Junior or Cadet Men/Women, no matter in which class he/she was registered at the tournament where he/she performed the record.  
A Junior Men/Women record is recognized if performed by a Cadet Men/Women, no matter in which class he/she was registered at the tournament where he/she performed the record if the format of the competition is the same for both (e.g. A cadet when participating in a FITA Round for Cadets can not break at the same time the Junior Records since the distances or the order in which they were shot are not the same.).  
Of course in all case the tournaments where the records are performed have to be duly registered with FITA.
